Staff reviewed report.

Welder opened the public hearing at 4:34 P.M.

Kumar Wickramasingha presented his plan to the commission. He explained his idea to create a safe and inviting environment for middle-school and high-school aged kids to receive tutoring and help with homework along with snacks and a meal at no cost to them. He plans to provide snacks and dinner to the children and volunteers Monday through Thursday after school. He has started a non-profit organization for funding purposes to accept donations. To help with fundraising he plans to offer cooking classes or dinners on the weekends in hopes to generate funding and for those occasions he has applied for a license to serve beer and wine. Brown asked how many different kids he plans to have and at this time the plan is 15 kids per day since that is what is budgeted, however he hopes the number increases with more funding. He mentioned that he has discussed with several teachers and hopes to have kids referred when they need help. The teachers will also be fed dinner in return for their time.
