Fort Madison Municipal Swimming Pool**

SWIMMING INSTRUCTOR - Qualifications: Must possess Water Safety Instructor Red Cross Certification, Certification in American Red Cross Life Guarding Today, Certification in American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer and Certification in American Red Cross Community First Aid, possess excellent verbal communication skills; honest, dependable and responsible; must have a desire to work with the public while being polite and courteous to all patrons. Must be 17 years of age and must reside within a 10-mile radius of Fort Madison.

Duties teach various skill levels of aquatic classes as assigned by the Aquatics Coordinator. Swimming Instructors may be responsible for other assigned duties as directed by the Aquatics Coordinator. Swimming Instructors will also perform Life guarding duties as needed.

Approximate starting/ending dates: June 14 to August 6. Rate of pay: \$7.50 to \$7.85 per hour depending on length of service.

Due to the number of applicants, completion of the life guarding class is not a guarantee of hire at the Fort Madison Municipal Swimming Pool.

The Parks and Recreation Department will reimburse "new" employees all certification costs based on a sliding scale (1/3 after first season, 1/3 after 2nd season and 1/3 after 3rd season) provided applicant is employed through the end of each summer season.

Uniforms will be provided. Additional uniforms are at employees' expense.
