NEWSPAPERS & MAGAZINES

Acceptable

Newspapers, Advertising
Supplements, Mail, Magazines,
Catalogs, Phone Books & Paper
Back Books (remove all plastic wrap
around magazines & catalogs.) Do not
bind newsprint or magazines.

OFFICE PAPER

Acceptable

Computer, typing, writing and
photocopy paper, envelopes, file
folders and shredded office paper.

Not Acceptable

Carbon paper, blueprint paper, film,
photographs or anything with a spiral
binder or fasteners.

TIN CANS

ALL tin & aluminum cans/lids are
acceptable.

PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS

Plastics accepted for recycling in Lee
County are types 1 through 7. Check
the bottom of the container for the
recycling logo. The number
identifying the type of plastic is inside
the logo.

Acceptable (examples)

Food Containers Shampoo Bottles
Milk Jugs Butter Containers
Detergent Bottles Bleach Jugs
Yogurt Containers PET Containers
Soda Juice Water Bottles

Not Acceptable

Toys dishes, waste cans, laundry
baskets, buckets, plastic bags, etc.

CARDBOARD

Acceptable

Cardboard Boxes (all boxes must be
empty & broken down), Brown Paper
Sacks, Cereal Boxes (please remove
liners), Chipboard, Beverage
Containers & Pizza Boxes

Please help us in keeping this a safe &
healthy work environment for our
employees by following the
guidelines below:

Absolutely NO syringes (hypodermic
needles) or medical equipment of any
kind. You can obtain syringe
containers & drop off the full
containers at the GRRWA offices.
We DO NOT accept Styrofoam, food
waste, insulation, house siding,
clothes or household trash of any
kind. All recyclables must be placed
in BLUE recycle bins loose (GRRWA
supplies your 1st bin for free with a
current water bill).

PLASTIC BAGS are NO longer
recyclable. DO NOT put full bags of
recyclables in the bins!! Bags of
recyclables on residential routes will
NOT be picked up!
